RAE License

• Why do you need to sit for RAE (Radio Amateur Exam) exam? So that you have a license to operate mobile or handheld radio.

Who issue the license?

The license is issued by MCMC (Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission) upon passing the RAE exam. License fees is RM 120 for 5 years plus RM 60 for the application.

How to sit for the exam?

The exam is held twice every year by MCMC. The next exam is in June 2010. Exam fees RM50.00 payable to MCMC.

Who can provide training class for this exam?

Penang eXpdc Club in collaboration with Penang YMCA is providing free training for members who are interested to sit for RAE exam.

You must be a member of Penang eXpdc Club and Penang YMCA to participate in this free class.
